

Notebook Check - Academic Recovery Opportunity

Freewrites: Each journal entry should have the following components in order to receive full credit:

- 1) **labeled** appropriately with the title using appropriate textual features;
- 2) should reflect consistent, focused writing and a length of at least **three paragraphs**;
- 3) have a **purpose** (entertain, inform, persuade);
- 4) includes **main idea** and **supporting details/examples**

Notes: Notes should be properly labeled and use **textual features** that help the reader understand main ideas and supporting details (bullets, indentations, bold/underlined words, spacing, etc.). Notes must be **complete and accurate** to receive full credit.

All work should be legible and neat.

All submitted notebooks should be in bound journal with meaningful order. (Points will be deducted if notebook is shared with another class unless properly sectioned; points will also be deducted for random blank pages between assignments/or other random work between assignments).
