Student Publishing Project: Summer Project

For this project, you will be creating a children's book of your very own!!

Project Requirements:

- 1. You'll be putting all your knowledge of literary elements, writing, grammar, and spelling to write an interesting children's story on one of the following topics:
 - a. How to survive middle school
 - b. Making and Keeping friends
 - c. Dealing with family issues
 - d. How to handle conflict
 - e. Discuss the importance of media
- 2. You must research your topic by reading other novels that have related themes. Write a Summary or complete two book reports of at least two novels related to your topic. This must be turned in with the final project.
- 3. Be creative and develop your own characters, conflicts, and plot line.
- 4. Do the following to develop your story. This process must be turned in as part of your final project
 - a. <u>Prewriting</u>: Story Board (Chart or flow map showing sequence of events and the plot).
 - b. <u>Story Elements:</u> Outline the setting of the story, Characterization of main Characters, and the type of dialogue that will take place between Characters in your story.
 - c. Typed Rough Draft
 - d. Revision & Editing: Handwritten changes should be reflected on your typed rough draft.
 - e. Typed Final Draft: Should reflect the written changes that were made on your rough draft.
- 5. Refer to current children's books and arrange another copy of your final draft into a form of a children's book and include illustrations. You may need to make changes to your book to accommodate your change in audience and format.
- 6. Your book must include a Title page, Dedication page, 15 pages of story with illustrations, and an about the Author page. A minimum of 5-7 sentences (not including pics) must be present on every page.
- 7. Get at least 4 people to read your book and provide comments and their opinion about the book. Use this information to Create a "brag page" for your book. Attach a Copy of your book reviews with your final project.
- 8. Be sure that the final draft of your book is well put together. Be creative and have fun with this activity!!!
