## Monday Business Attire:

Girls: (Blazer with school crest Burgundy, \#43 plaid or charcoal gray flannel skirt, Oxford Shirt White (button down only), cross bow tie (Burgundy or \#43 plaid), Socks/Tights Gray/Burgundy/Black/White, and all black dress shoes not sneakers.

Boys: (Blazer with school crest Burgundy, dress gray pants, Oxford Shirt White (button down only), Tie - Boys Burgundy or \#43 plaid and all black dress shoes not sneakers.

## Footwear, Outerwear \& Accessories:

[] Socks/Tights (Gray/Khaki/Burgundy/Black/White) [] Shoes - Solid BLACK leather shoes/sneakers (No sandals or boots ever)
[] Tie - Boys (Burgundy or \#43 plaid)
[] Tie - Girls Cross Bow Tie ONLY(Burgundy or \#43 plaid)
[] Belt (Belt BLACK with plain buckle)
[] Jewelry (no oversize jewelry of any kind) (No earring for boys)
[] \#43 plaid Hair accessories or solid Burgundy

## Reminders:

- Sweaters and Jackets worn during the school day must be Burgundy.
- Tank tops, V-neck, crew neck, fitted $t$-shirts etc. are NOT part of the uniform.
- Shirts can be plain or have The Champion Crest. (Shirts may not have other logos such as Abercrombie, Aeropostale, Lacoste, Polo, etc.)
- Jeans, Leggings, Capri, Skinny Jeans, Cargo Pants and Corduroys are NOT part of the uniform.
- Outer Coats (not to be worn in class)
- No Head Gear (scarves, bandannas, big bows, etc.)
- White button down shirt cannot be worn with any other uniform except BUSINESS ATTIRE
- All shoes must be SOLID BLACK

The consequences for not following the uniform code are as follows:
